

Magento Facile Login Extension (Magento 1.2.x - 1.4.x)

1. Steps for Installation

- 1) Extract the zip file `facilelogin.zip` to a local folder.
- 2) Copy file `Gallery /app/etc/modules/ Ecsso_FacileLogin.xml` to `/app/etc/modules`
- 3) Copy the full folder `FacileLogin /app/code/local/Ecsso` to `/app/code/local`
- 4) Copy the template, layout, css and js files to corresponding directories
- 5) Add this code

In the file " `app/design/frontend/<your theme>/<your theme>/template/page/html/header.phtml`", is to be added the below given code.

Please add the below code in the corresponding phtml file.

NB: Please ensure that there is no “special characters” included in the code while doing the copy-paste. To prevent this you can first paste the above code to a notepad, then copy from there and paste to the phtml. Also, we are attaching sample files for your easy reference (customer.xml, header.phtml)
